Leslie Oakley's Story

In our dining room sits a United States map and a globe. A sign hangs nearby with the verse, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations" (Matthew 28:19). It sits as a conversation piece, but more importantly as a reminder of what God began working in me in 2011.

It was after the tornadoes that devastated Alabama in the spring of 2011 that I had my first experience with serving my home state. Working side-by-side with friends and family, as well as church family, we cleaned and cleared the properties of complete strangers. It was there that my passion for serving began, and it was there that I saw firsthand that teenagers can and will serve with a passion that matched or exceeded mine.

In the years that followed, I would look for age-appropriate opportunities for my family to serve. In the early years it was as simple as collecting donations for natural disaster relief or packing meals for our community. As my children grew, so did my heart for teaching them to be ready to "Go."

In 2019, Faith Church announced an opportunity to serve at our Children's HopeChest care point in Guatemala, and I was ready. So was my 14-year-old! We prayed and planned, raised funds, and had lots of faith moments before we even stepped foot in Cuyotenango.

Throughout our time in Guatemala we had moments where God really showed up in ways we never expected. Language barriers can pose many issues, but not once did we struggle with communicating the love of Jesus. From VBS crafts with preschoolers and games played with teens from both Cuyotenango and Florence, to worshiping our Savior in two languages simultaneously, every moment was beautiful.

Audrey and I look forward to more mission opportunities through Faith Church, and with the love and support of our Kingdom Builders we know the opportunities will be endless.
